DEAR READER,

Have you ever lain awake at night and wondered about a decision you made? If you'd made a different choice, would your life have ricocheted off in a different direction? This idea has kept me up at night, and also planted the seed for the story that eventually became *This Spells Love*.

In the pandemic, after my breadmaking phase, I hit a point where the only entertainment I could consume was '90s-era romantic comedies (or grisly murder books). I binged all of my favorites: While You Were Sleeping, 10 Things I Hate About You, and My Best Friend's Wedding. I loved that each and every time, I was guaranteed a laugh and a satisfying happily ever after. My rom-coms never hurt me. They left me feeling safe. From that feeling, Gemma Wilde was born. Too risk-averse to see that the love of her life has always been in her passenger seat. Her handsome and charming ride-or-die has been secretly pining for her all through her lackluster relationship with her ex. It would take a small miracle for Gemma to acknowledge her feelings . . . or a love spell.

And no rom-com is complete without a wacky cast of side characters. Gemma's aunt Livi, a quirky bookshop owner who may "see" more than she lets on, and Kiersten, Gemma's tell-it-like-it-is older sister, provide the perfect peers to give Gemma the push she needs to cleanse her ex from her life. In a *Practical Magic* "Put the Lime in the Coconut" moment, the three, along with Dax, perform a spell that will make Gemma see her life and her relationships from a whole new angle.

I set this novel in Hamilton, Canada. It's a city about an hour west of Toronto that's undergone a bit of an extreme makeover over the last few years. Its up-and-coming downtown is the perfect setting for two city-savvy millennials to open their custom sneaker shop and clean beauty supply store (while still having the historic Victorian architecture to support a possibly magical bookshop). I loved infusing the bits of Canadiana culture. From music to food (you must try ketchup chips!) to recreational curling (my goal was to write the horniest curling scene ever to be published by Penguin Random House).

I hope that you enjoy it—and all of Gemma and Dax's adventures—as these two lovebirds learn that the best risks in life are the ones you take with your heart.

RECIPE

Aunt Livi's Moonlight Margaritas

Some nights require a strong cup of tea. Others, a brisk walk or a quiet moment of reflection. But when the moon is just right, sometimes you get a night where the perfect potion is one of my famous moonlight margaritas.



FOR THE SAGE-INFUSED TEQUILA:

- 1½ cups Casamigos Reposado Tequila (the handsome George Clooney really does make a delightful tequila, but any reposado will work)
- 3 sprigs of fresh sage (promotes wisdom and healing, also gives a lovely little zip!)

FOR THE MARGARITA:

- 2 tbsp. sage-infused tequila 1 tbsp. orange juice
- 1-1/2 tbsp. lime juice
- $1-\frac{1}{2}$ 2 tsp. agave (to taste)

FOR THE RIM:

- Mix equal parts sugar, orange zest and salt (I like a nice coarse sea salt for its purifying and healing properties)
- I wedge of lime

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Pour your tequila into a glass jar and add the sprigs of sage. Seal and store in your refrigerator to let it steep for 24–48 hours (the longer the trip, the bigger the zip!).
- 2. Rim your glass using a lime wedge and salt/sugar/orange zest mixture.
- 3. Combine the margarita ingredients with a few cubes of ice in a blender and blend.
- 4. Garnish with a sprig of sage, lime wedge, or orange slice.
- 5. Drink, dance, and share all your troubles with the moon.
